The Predictive Safety Testing Consortium (PSTC) launched its 15th anniversary celebration with a virtual public workshop. Scientists and experts from the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA), the pharmaceutical industry, academia, and Critical Path Institute (C-Path) discussed PSTC's work in the regulatory space, its current efforts in researching fluid biomarkers as predictive tools of drug-induced organ injury, the future of biomarker research, and opportunities for industry, consortia and other organizations to collaborate with PSTC to identify and qualify novel safety biomarkers for use during drug development.
