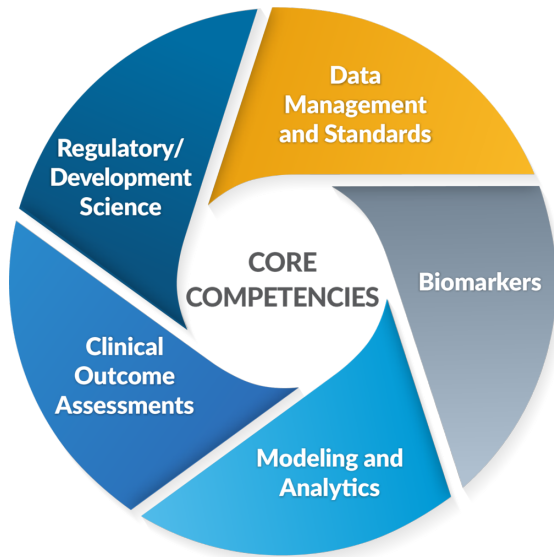


C-Path Wraps Up Productive Leadership Retreat, In-Person Meetings
