



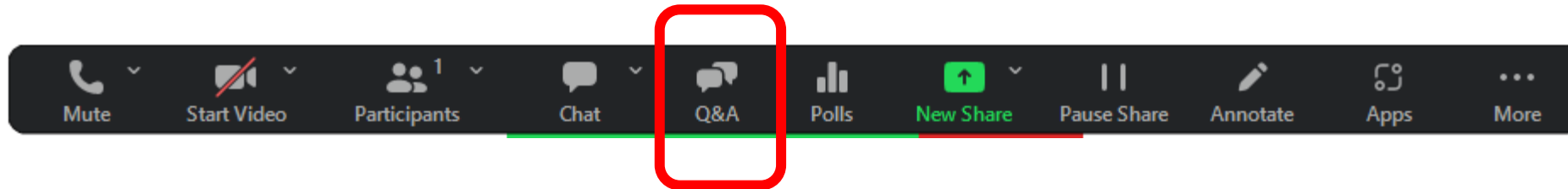

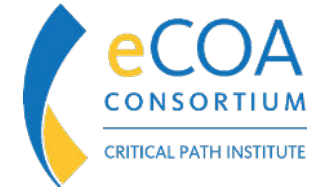

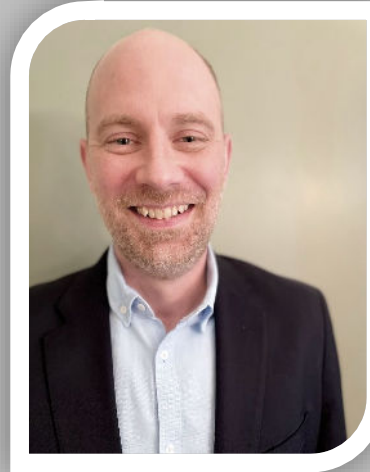

Overview: eCOA Translations Implementation



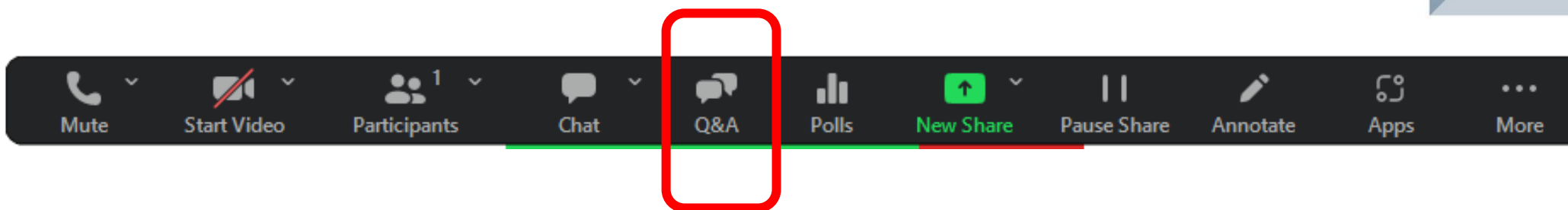
- A collaborative process between eCOA provider and Translations provider
- Goal: Accurately migrate COA translations into eCOA systems for trial use
- Can be accomplished in a variety of ways, but generally includes:
 - eCOA provider providing “Handoff package”, including English eCOA screens and technical files, to Translations provider
 - Translations provider migrating eCOA translations into the technical files
 - eCOA provider loading technical files into their eCOA system
 - Translations provider proofreading the output to ensure accuracy of translated screens
